Subplans

- If 'Other Requirements' is displayed on a degree audit, a subplan is needed.



Other Requirements

Complete 1 of the following: Computer Science Thesis (A) or Computer Science NonThs (B)

- When a subplan gets added to the student's CPP, 'Other Requirements' will disappear, and the appropriate degree audit requirements associated with the subplan will then display.



Milestones

Milestones exist in two places...

1. Built into the Academic Requirements for graduate degree programs.
2. Added to student records by the RO via a query and batch process performed at least once per semester.

Milestones on the student record must be manually marked “Completed” for the milestones to show as satisfied in the Academic Requirements (degree audit). Some milestones should have the date of the event entered in the “Date Attempted” field as well (bottom right corner).

Note: If a student changes majors (between master’s and doctorate) or subplans (Plan A or Plan B), then the milestones in the student record will be wrong. When the batch process is run again, missing milestones will be added but previous milestones that are no longer needed will need to be removed manually by the grad units. Alternatively, the grad units may add the new milestones and delete the old milestones without waiting for the batch process.

The faculty name must be entered in the “Milestone Title” field, in the space just below the blue-shaded area of these milestones: Thesis Director, Dissertation Director, Guidance Committee Chair.

- **Correct:** J. Smith, Professor Emeritus
- **Incorrect:** John Smith, Professor Emeritus

Be careful not to use these fields for the faculty name: “Comment” field; “Advisor/Evaluator” field.

MSU is not currently using the Advisors section, with the *Advisor/Evaluator field, in the milestones. This is confusing because the asterisk is built into the page. However, just ignore that section.

Note: Only the Graduate School completes these two milestones:

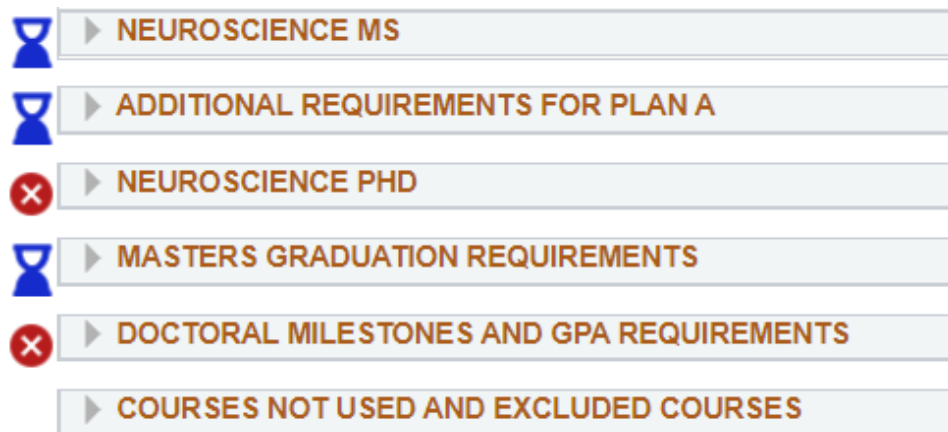
- Master’s Thesis
- Dissertation

After filling in the Thesis/Dissertation title, the date accepted, and sending the document to ProQuest, the Grad School adds a note in the “Comment” field indicating the ***semester*** the Thesis/Dissertation was accepted. This is important because the student’s graduation semester cannot be *before* the Thesis/Dissertation completion. Grad staff should check this. Make sure that the student’s graduation application is in the same semester. In some cases, the grad staff will need to push the graduation application to the next semester. (In the CPP stack, add a new row, change the date of the graduation application to the next semester.)

Degree Clearance

Hiding doctoral requirements to clear a masters




- If a PhD and master's degree are both active on a student’s record, the PhD requirements will most likely need to be turned off to enable to confer the master's degree.



- To turn off the PhD requirements, go to the CPP stack and add a row (use DATA as the Program Action). On the Student Plan tab, set the Advisement Status to 'Do Not Include'.

- With the PhD requirements turned off, the audit should show only the master's requirements.

- Note that after the master's degree has been conferred, the PhD requirements will need to be turned back on by adding another row and setting the Advisement Status back to 'Include'.

Other degree clearance tips

- Putting a CONF into the degree clearance screen does not mean that a student will automatically get their degree conferred. There are many checks in the system that the student must pass before their degree is awarded. Putting in a CONF is just one of those checks.
- Rather than using DENY or MOVE in the decisions area when a student is not going to graduate in a given term, please go to the CPP stack and move the APPL row to another term.
