I. First Year (for all RCS MA and PhD students)

Implementation of the Discussion-Based Training in RCS:

The minimum 6 hours of discussion-based training that are required for the MSU RCR plan will be completed by all first-year SPN and FRN MA and PhD students upon successful completion of the required course ROM 803 (Foundations of Contemporary Language Teaching).
